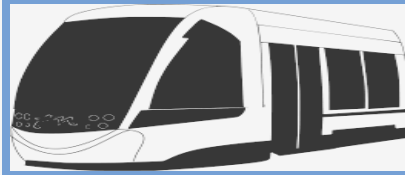


Travelling by Train to Mainland Hospital Appointments

Concessions for
Patients



There is no peak time restriction if the cardholder is travelling to a hospital appointment which they can only get to by travelling between 06:00 and 09:00 or between 16:30 and 18.00. Written proof, in the form of an appointment card or other clear written evidence regarding the time and date of an appointment at a Health Board hospital, must be produced on request. This will include at time of ticket purchase and on mode of travel where ticket inspections are undertaken.
